Rules

There are two leagues split according to regions designated West and East.

Each match consists of nine 1st to 7 point handicap games played according to Rule 21 of the WCF GC Rules 6th Edition. There will be three rounds: 2 doubles, 4 singles, and 2 singles and 1 doubles. There is no restriction on which 2 players play in the doubles games but all singles games must be played in handicap order.

All games are played Advantage Handicap, without a time limit. However, if captains agree, a time limit may be imposed, either at the outset or during the match, should it be expedient to do so. If a time limit is imposed and the game is unfinished, then the winner of the game must be calculated as set out in the document "How to play Advantage GC" or more simply by using the Winner Scale.

When a fixture is played at a club using only a single lawn the home team must contact their visitors well before the match to discuss and agree the planned schedule of play. As with all SECF Leagues, the format of the match may be adjusted to take
